A Short Biography

Kai Yiu Chan is currently an Associate Professor of History Department at Tunghai University, Taiwan. Graduated from the University of Oxford (D. Phil.), his research interests include Chinese business institutions, organizational structure, accounting system, and cross-cultural business practices. He is the author of *Business Expansion and Structural Change in Pre-war China: Liu Hongsheng and His Enterprises, 1920-1937* (Hong Kong, Hong Kong University Press, 2006), and several articles on Chinese business institutions and finance, such as the comprador system, private banking, trade associations, and grain trade networks, and on the migration, socio-economic history, and costume business of the Taiwan Aborigines. He is currently conducting a research project on the Chinese grain trade networks and transformation in business organization and finance.
