



Procedures on Approval for Tentative Graduation Thesis Topic for 4-year Curriculum Students

4-year curriculum History Major students should write a thesis in their final year of attendance under the supervision of an instructor for fulfilment of History Major requirements. Student who will graduate in 2015-2016 under the new curriculum, no matters he/she has been endorsed by an instructor to be his/her thesis supervisor or not, he/she will be enrolled to the course of HIST4801 in 2015-16 Term 1.

◆ Procedure (1)

Students should approach their potential supervisors initially for Graduation Thesis writing:

Initial communication between student and Supervisor	Jan-February 2015
Tentative topic approved by Supervisor	May 2015
Submitted the Tentative Topic of Graduation Thesis form	May 2015
First bibliography and outline submitted to Supervisor	June 2015
Active consultations with Supervisor for summer research	June-September 2015
Thesis proposal approved by Supervisor	July 2015

◆ Procedure (2)

Students should submit the completed Tentative Topic of Graduation Thesis form with endorsement of the supervisors to General Office of History Department by 29 May 2015. The form can be downloaded in the webpage of History Department.

Remarks: Each supervisor can supervise up to 5 Undergraduate final year students per academic year.
